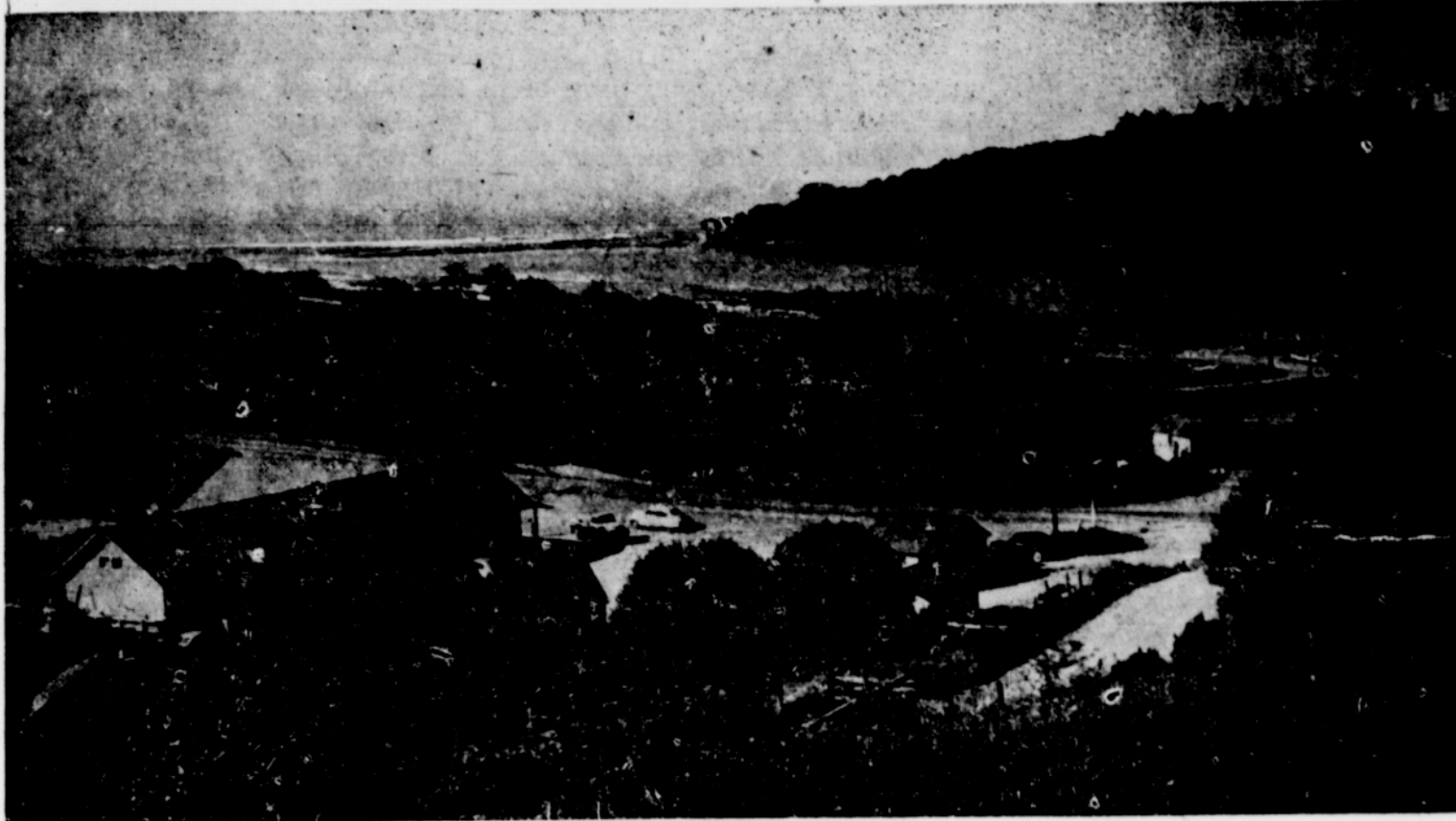
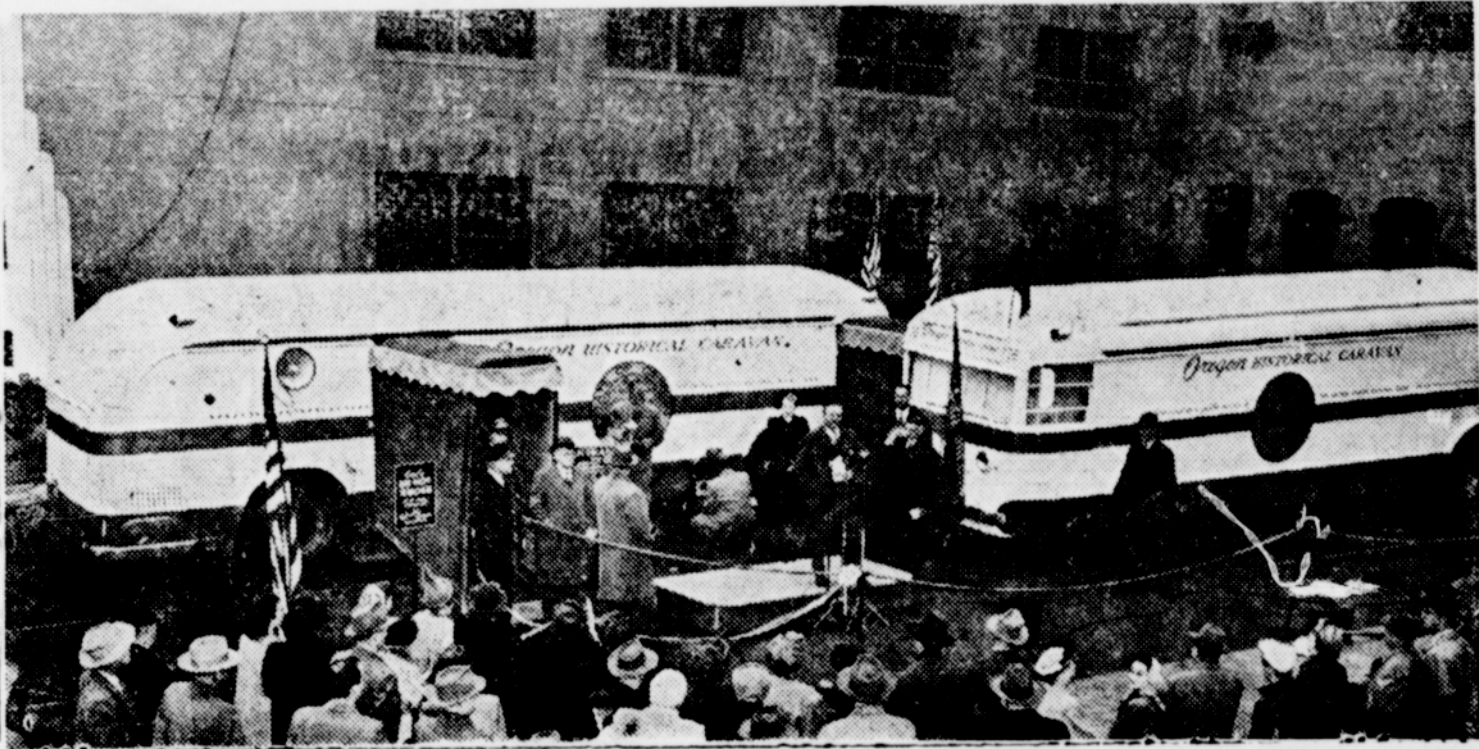


Chetco River Mouth, Probable "Site Of Development"

iting at the Skopec home. Miss Montgomery will return to Eugene to be employed at the hos-

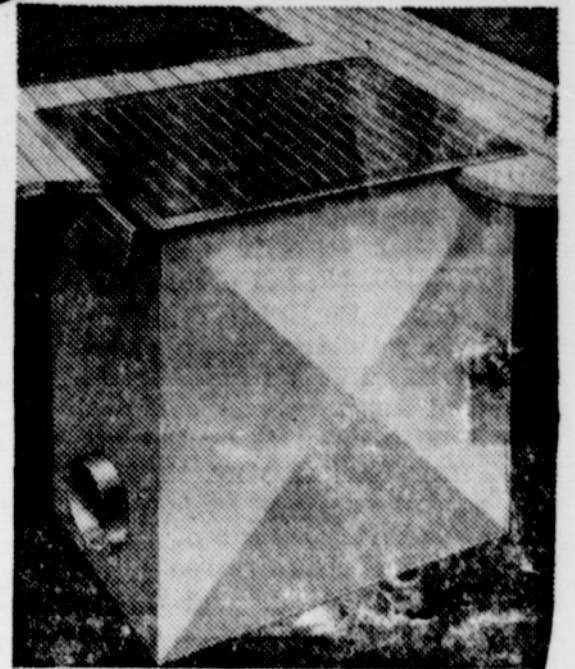
