School Age Stated In State "Code"

Several individuals have recently asked concerning at what age a child may enter school. Oregon school law, section 111-1051, sets up the following requirement:

"The district board shall admit free of charge to the schools of

their district, all persons between the age of six and 21 residing therein—provided that a child entering school for the first time during the fall term shall be deemed to be six year of age if his birthday occurs on or before November 15."

In line with the recommendation of the Curry County School Superintendent, and in keeping with past policy of the district, the local school board decided that it would again be the policy of the district that exceptions could not be made to entrance age requirement as outlined in Section 11-1051, quoted above. This is especially necessary considering the influx of school children to the district because of the plywood plant and the increased business and lumber activity.

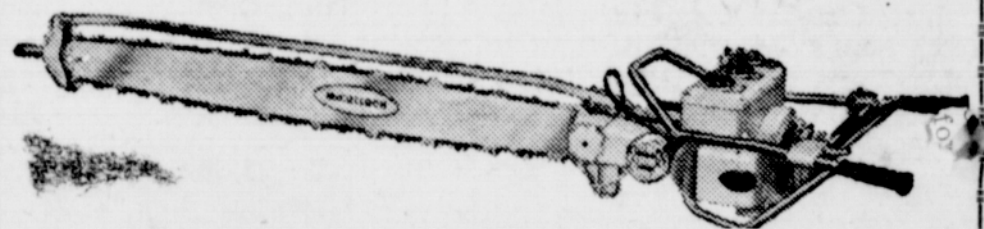
