**Relief For Korea By Oregon Farmers**

PORTLAND, Aug. 13 (Special) —Over 8500 Oregon wheat farmers and grain growers were urged today to help the needy peoples of Korea and India in a statewide appeal for food and clothing by the Oregon Relief for Korea and India.

The appeal was issued by Dr. Salem Council of Churches and chairman of the food drive.

"Greatest immediate need is for wheat and grain," Sword said. "Vast areas of grain fields have been destroyed in Korea by military action. Still larger areas in India have been ruined by

floods, drought and earthquakes. The need for food in these countries is staggering. The relief effort is urgent need, but are not adequate," he stated.

Sword said that the Oregon gifts will be loaded on a friendship food and clothing ship which is scheduled to sail in October, in time to bring relief to people of those destitute countries before the harsh winter sets in.

Along with wheat and grain, dehydrated foods, powdered milk and eggs, potatoes, onions, sugar and vitamins are urgently needed, Sword added.

Oregon Relief for Korea and India, an organization composed of 17 religious, veterans' and agriculture groups, has designated

August for the food drive and September for the clothing appeal.

Governor Douglas McKay is honorary state chairman for the campaign.

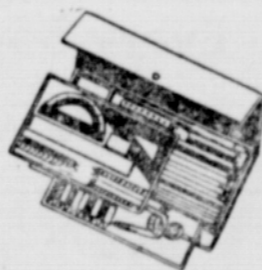
