F. S. Bridge Is Almost Down

The Forest Service is constructing a new standard highway two-lane bridge across the North of the Chetco river on the north bank Chetco road five miles east of Brookings. The new structure will be a steel-girder bridge with reinforced concrete deck. It will be 26 feet wide with additional two feet for guards and guard rails on each side. Length of bridge is 165 feet. Approximately 450 cubic yards of concrete, 30,500 pounds of reinforcing steel, and 226,000 pounds of structure steel will be used in the new structure.

The contract for the bridge was awarded to the Port Construction Company of Port Angeles, Wash. Contract price was \$52,395 plus the structural steel which was furnished by the Forest Service, making a total cost of approximately \$85,000. Completion date of contract is October 15, 1951.

The approach fill will be put in by the Forest Service and will consist of approximately 12,000 cubic yards of material. The fill put in after bridge construction is completed. The Forest Service will then dismantle the present structure.
