Important Notice

The secretary of the Pacific Bulb Growers association, Clifford Walker, of Albany, Oregon, received a telegram from the Jobbers' association of New York, worrying about the rumors concerning growers selling 7-8-inch bulbs below the agreed price, 15c.

Mr. Walker (who is as busy as any grower can be) rushed down here and made a thorough investigation in all the bulb growing districts, and found the following everywhere: There is an almost complete failure of lily crops north of Gold Beach, due to the hard freezes of last winter.

In Curry, Del Norte and Humboldt counties there is a decided shortage of 8s and up. Very few growers are able to completely fill their orders for 8s, 9s and 10s. There is a grand scramble to get 8s. They are especially short.

Several dealers have offered to take 40 per cent of their growers 7s at the agreed price, 15c. Many growers who thought they were going to have a surplus of 7s and planned to plant them back are finding that by the time they are through they have no 7s to plant.

The price for 7 and 8-inch bulbs remains 15c. They are selling them for this price in all districts.
