IN THE NAME OF THE STATE OF OREGON: You are hereby required to appear and answer the complaint filed against you in the above entitled Court and cause, on or before the expiration of four weeks from the date of the first publication of this summons, to-wit: You must so appear and answer on or before the 6th day of December, 1951. If you fail to so appear and answer, for want thereof, the Plaintiff will apply to the above entitled Court for the relief prayed for in his complaint; that is, for the decree of said Court forever dissolving the bonds of matrimony heretofore and now existing between the Plaintiff and the Defendant and granting a decree of absolute divorce in favor of the Plaintiff and against the Defendant and for such other and further relief as to the Court may seem just and equitable.
