In addition to the talks to be given by the Jefimenkos, there will be several musical numbers. Earl Breuer is chairman of the party.

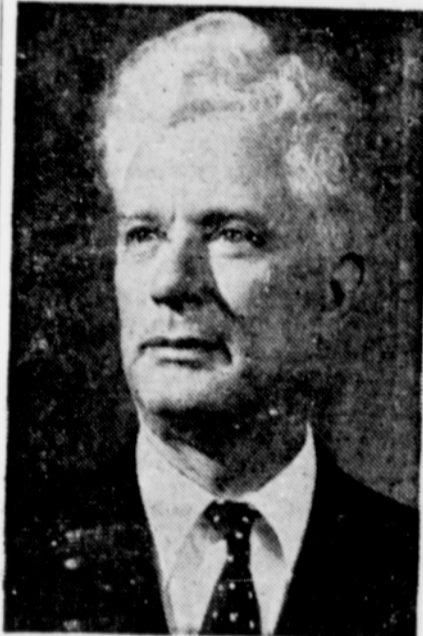

Marshall N. Dana, assistant to the president of the United States National Bank, was selected "Oregon's man of the year" by the East Side Commercial Club at its 43rd annual banquet Wednesday, said the Oregon Journal of Dec. 14.
