

## Bank Charter Was Granted Brookings

by local business people and outside interests.

"The organizers are in position to keep sufficient capitalization for the needs of the area and this will be increased from time to time as conditions warrant. The area has been without a bank since 1932 and the new bank will come at a most opportune time to serve the people."

Original incorporators are: R. O. Dimmick, merchant and mayor of Brookings; Edwin Sund, general manager of Brookings Plywood Corporation; Howard Carl Mason, chief engineer of the same company; Wilson Freeman and Henry Kerr, merchants; W. L. Crissey, retired; George Funk, farmers, and these experienced bankers: Frank E. Langer, A. R. Bergman and E. L. Morton.

"Most of these have been residents of Brookings for some years and Mr. Langer is president of Kitsap County Bank at Port Orchard and First National Bank of Paulsbo, Wash.; Mr. Berkman is vice-president of People National Bank of Seattle, a former resident of Corvallis and Lebanon; E. L. Morton, native Oregonian, who has worked his entire life in

banking. For the past 18 years he was with First National Bank of Portland in various managerial posts, having established a branch for them at Heppner in 1934, and was subsequently manager of the Newberg and Hood River. He comes to Brookings from Salem where he was an assistant manager of the Salem branch four years. He will be the president and active manager of the new bank.

"The directors will be named in due course, and the new bank to be in active operation with the least possible delay, as the community can ill afford any further delay, in obtaining bank service.

"Application has been made and approval expected soon for membership in the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation, whereby each patron's account will be fully insured under federal regulations up to the legal maximum of \$10,000,000."

### A. A. Rogers Reports

"March 7—I have as of today approved of the application for authority to organize the Oregon State Bank at Brookings.

"I feel that the Brookings community needs banking service and that there is sufficient business to support a well-managed institution in southern Curry County.

"The proposed bank is being formed for legitimate objects,

as contemplated by banking law.

"I have confidence in the men who filed this application and am sure that the business of the bank will be honestly and efficiently conducted. In my investigation of the character, financial responsibility and business methods of the applicants, it was my conclusion that this group of citizens command the confidence and respect of the community and are capable and competent to serve as officers and directors. I feel that the bank will be successfully managed by E. L. Morton, who has had many years of banking experience, and it is my hope that as time passes and the people learn to know the officers, directors and stockholders, that they will realize a keen appreciation of the efforts made on their behalf and to the state of having banking service available." — A.
