To vote on the following question: Shall the Board of School District No. 17C, Curry County, be authorized to purchase for school purposes the property described below and expend district back tax and serial levy moneys now on hand not exceeding \$17,978.74 in payment for the property.

### Mole Control Will Be Done In Month

GOLD BEACH—Inquiries are coming in to the county extension office as to how to kill moles and gophers. Now, during the months of March and April is the time to control these rodents.

Mole control through the use of liquid thallium is quite effective. Angle worms are soaked in liquid thallium for 6 to 8 hours or over night and then dropped into the mole runways with a probe. The hole must be covered so that light does not get into the runway and the worms must be used soon after treating because they disintegrate so rapidly.

For gopher control Clifford Jenkins recommends carrots or

A few rules were made and added to the by-laws for collecting fines. A limit of 14 members was

raisins sprinkled with alkaloid strychnine at the rate of one ounce of strychnine to eight lbs of carrots or raisins. These are dropped in the gopher runways the same as for the moles.

The worms are treated with liquid thallium for mole control and should be dropped five or six inches below the ground, and are not put in the surface runways. They should be handled with tweezers and rubber gloves after they are treated. There is very little danger to dogs and cats as moles die in the runways and do not come to the surface.
