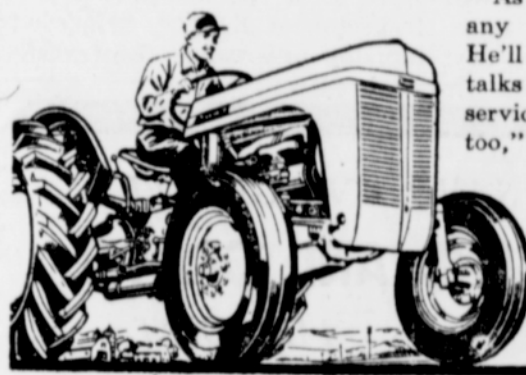
The next party in the series will be held this coming Saturday, April 5 at 8 o'clock, as it otherwise would fall on the day before Easter, which is not desirable.
