

West Coast Tele. Co. Adds New Phones In Section From Eureka, Cal. Northward

COOS BAY—West Coast Telephone Company is moving ahead with its plan for expansion of telephone service in this section of Oregon. On March 12 the Port Orford dial automatic telephone equipment was cut into service in the new building recently erected by the company, according to George McBride, district manager.

Additional equipment for 50 lines is scheduled for installation channels between Coos Bay and Crescent City, with facilities for within the next two months. Twenty new lines have been added to the Smith River exchange and a similar addition at the Klamath, California, exchange.

West Coast technicians under equipment installation supervisor, Robert Hayes, are in course of installing carrier equipment, at an estimated cost of \$56,280, that will provide immediately eight new channels between Coos Bay and Crescent City, with facilities for expansion to 12 channels as the service requires. This installation will be cut into service sometime in the next two or three weeks. Repeater stations have been installed at Port Orford and Gold Beach in connection with this carrier equipment. These stations are equipped with their own separate power plants, so that there will be no breakdown in service to due to failures of the public power supply anywhere along the system.

"Equipment for the installation of a similar carrier system between Crescent City and Eureka has been ordered," said McBride. "If we receive the equipment on schedule delivery we should be able to complete this installation sometime next May. Throughout this entire area we are straining our every resource to meet the rapidly growing demand for telephone service. We anticipate a long term continuation of this very rapid development."
