CAMP DESERT ROCK, Nev.—Cpl. Kenneth A. Janicke, son of Mr. and Mrs. A. V. Moore, of Brookings, is taking part in the atomic test series currently being conducted by the Atomic Energy Commission and the Department of Defense at Camp Desert Rock, Nevada.

The tests are designed to give American fighting men and their leaders a clearer picture of various aspects of atomic warfare.

Cpl. Janicke is serving as a motor vehicle operator in Company E, of the 369 Engineer Amphibious Support Regiment, Shore Battalion, which has been preparing for these tests at Camp Desert Rock since Dec., 1951.

Before entering the army at Fort Worden, Wash., Jan. 1951, Janicke was employed by the Swan Lumber Co. as logger.

### LOCAL NEWS

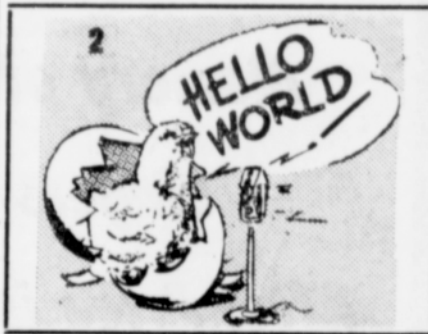

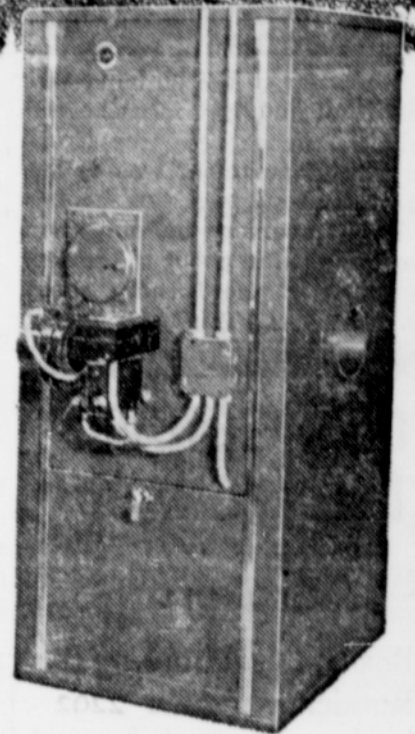
