Chetco Home and Auto Supply Co. opened its business in 1945 with Roy and Faye Sunderland, at the present Shell Service station site. This burned just prior to the opening date. A new location, however, was found in the Ben Gardner building, now occupied by Olympia Hardware & Supply Co.

From a small stock the business grew and in 1948, was moved to the Grayshel building with a half-interest being sold to Virgil and Marjorie Goldsberry. The stock was greatly increased in this move.

In 1950 the Sunderlands sold their interest to Donald Craig, and the store was remodeled and enlarged still some more.
