

Vets Bonds Sold; Payments To Come

GOLD BEACH—Oregon's \$46,000,000 in bonus bonds were sold April 23, at an effective interest rate of 1.71%, reports C. E. Seger, county service officer. The winning bond bid of three submitted was that of a syndicate headed by National City Bank of New York, Harr's Trust & Savings Bank, Chicago, and First National Bank of Portland. The bids were opened in the office of Veterans Affairs Director William G. Gaarenstroom, at the State Library building, Salem.

The total cost in interest will amount to \$9,239,507. The bonds will be retired over a period of 20 years, starting October 1, '53. They will be retired at the rate of \$2,000,000 yearly from 1963 through 1966, and \$3,000,000 annually from 1967 through 1972.

It will take about two months to print the bonds and inspect,

seal, sign and deliver them to the successful bidder and receive the bonus funds. As soon as the veterans department gets the money, bonus checks will go in the mail.

All applicants whose claims have been approved by June 30 will receive their payments in July. To date more than 50,000 claims have been approved for an average payment of nearly \$420.

The speed with which claims are paid depends entirely on how fast applications come in, Gaarenstroom said. Veterans currently are billing at a rate 'far too low' to maintain efficient operations in he warned.

State treasury officials said the winning bid was "extremely favorable" and saved about \$4,800,000 over the probable cost had the bonds been sold to state agencies, as was proposed last winter.

C. E. Seger urges all living veterans who may be eligible to file immediately. Forms are obtainable at the court house, post office, and at the service officer's home. Survivors of deceased eligible veterans are urged to apply through the county service officer as certain certifications are required, depending on the case. These may be obtained without cost through his office.

Lincoln County on the Oregon Coast was created February 20, 1893, by the state legislature and was named for Abraham Lincoln, the 16th president of the United States. The county has a land area of 1006 square miles.
