GOLD BEACH — School districts throughout the county will vote on Monday, May 19, on the question of exceeding the 6% limitation for the 1952-1953 school year by \$161,105.28.

More teachers and other employees have been added because of increased enrollment in practically every school district in the county. The Rural School Board included in the equalized county budget amounts which the board felt would allow for adequate operational expenses of all schools.
