Item 1. GASOLINE; to be pumped in school busses at service station or garage. Bidder to specify grade of gasoline, delivered price per gallon less excise tax.

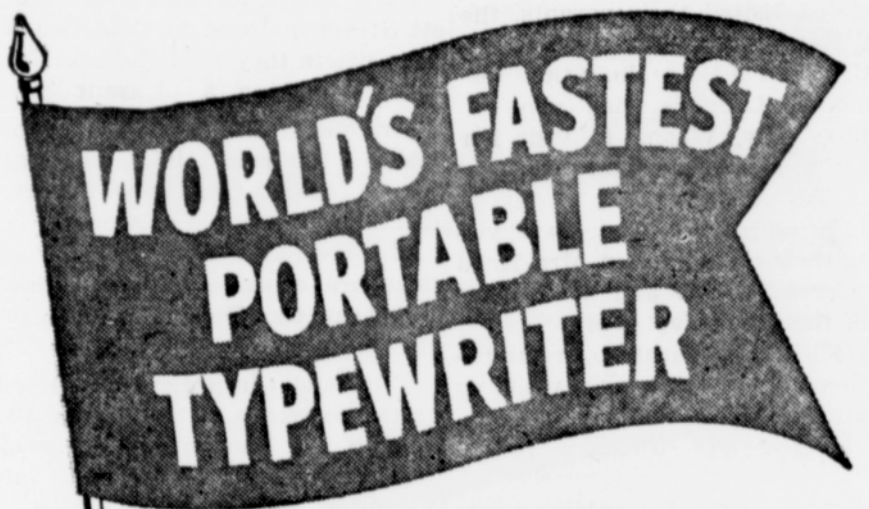

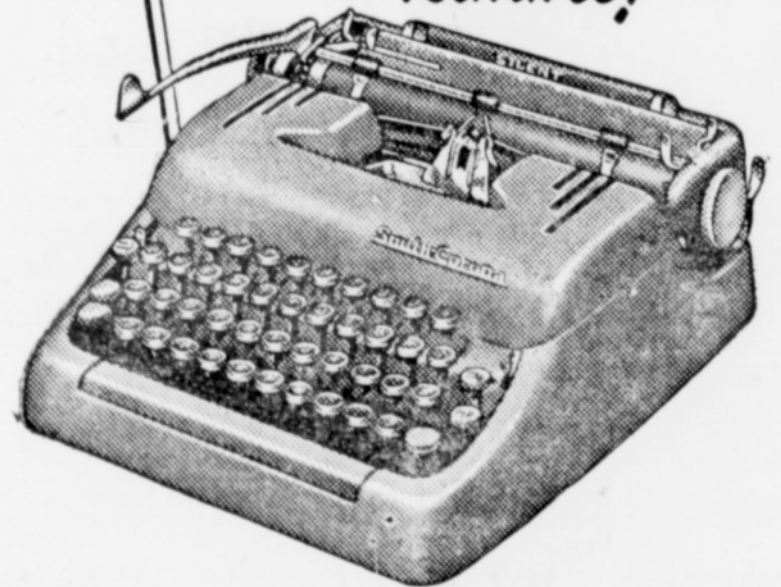
