Brookings post office became a second class office several years ago, when the stamp sales reached a certain point to justify the elevation of class rating.

Since that date, the receipts of the office have climbed with each succeeding quarter out-stripping the previous one.

According to Mrs. Swearingen, acting post master, the first quarter of 1952 show:

Stamp sales	4,087.31
