

### Bandon Measured Beavers Twice In Week-end Games, 8 To 2 and 9 To 6

The trip to Bandon for the beginning of the second half South-western Oregon league play didn't bring the Brookings Beavers any better luck, Saturday, as the Millers took both games, 8 to 2 and 9 to 6.

The Saturday night tilt played in shivering cold weather was a respectable ball game until the last of the seventh when two hits, two walks off the tiring Jim Nierman, plus two Beaver errors put the game on ice for the Millers.

Bailey Brem, big OSC right hander, had the Beavers on his hip, scattering seven hits and striking out 11. Bill Darnell and Keith Johnson, each with two hits, lead the Beavers at the plate.

Jim Lowman, Beaver pitcher, was unable to obtain plane reservations from Portland which forced Jerry Kane who had relieved Saturday night, to start the Sunday game. Kane pitched well enough until the sixth. Two doubles, Bill Hanauska's second home run and three bases on balls drove him to cover. Bill Wallace came in from second base and gave a good relief performance.

The Beavers out-hit the Millers, tagging Hanauska for 12 hits. The difference was that 12 Brookings base runners were left stranded. Frank Burdell, Bill Darnell, Jerry Mason and first baseman Jim Nierman each had two hits.

The Beavers travel to North Bend next week-end for a pair of games against the second place Lumber Jacks.
