

## Adventists Holding Annual Meeting At Gladstone

Brookings Seventh-Day Adventists are joining those from 104 others cities and town in Western Oregon in their annual gathering at conference camp grounds at Gladston park, 10 miles south of Portland, Willard Graham and Frank Tompkinson, local church officers and Arthur Robison, home missionary leader, will take part in the lay preachers' institute which was held the first three days of the ten-day encampment, from July 17 to 27. Reports say that 15,000 will attend during the two week-ends. Half of these will be housed on the grounds while the remainder will commute from Portland and other nearby cities.

Mason Metcalf, pastor of the Brookings church, has been on the grounds for ten days helping 64 brother ministers set up the camp. By Thursday a mushroom town of 1750 lodges, cabins and tents, with its own water system, cafeteria, groceries, police and fire staffs, were set up on the 70-acre tract which the Oregon conference purchased in 1932 for these annual gatherings.

George E. Vandeman of the General Conference Ministerial association will instruct the lay ministers. Besides the three days of training, there will be reports from prominent laymen who have engaged in public evangelistic services, radio work and other missionary activities during the past year. Platform interviews with some of the persons won by lay efforts will be featured.

Elder W. H. Branson, General Conference president, and the Voice of Prophecy radio group, will be featured during the last week-end.
