

### Jacks Took Couple From Beavers Over Past Week-end

Brookings Beavers had another hectic week-end, losing both ends of a double-header to Coos Bay-North Bend Lumberjacks, at that place by 24 to 5 and 6 to 5 scores.

The Saturday night tilt was almost a Brookings victory with the Beavers leading 5 to 3 going into the last of the ninth but the Jacks scored three runs to end the near upset. Five Brookings errors spelled the difference as the previous three Jacks runs off Jim Lowman were unearned.

The fateful last of the ninth started with Glenn Stetter barely beating out an infield hit to short. Giant First Baseman Arlitt then got his only hit of the game by tripling to left center and plating Stetter. Arlitt scored the tying run as Dick Wenner trickled a hit between third and short. Pitcher Lowman was working desperately to hold the time.

Joe Sugura, batting for Allison, flied out to Matson in center and Jim Ruggles, hitting for Lewis struck out, making it two down. Ken Jensen then hit a grounder over the bag at second which Wallace deflected with his glove but could not hold and it went for a hit. Ward Rocky scored Wenner with the winning run by hitting a bat-handle blooper over third to end the torrid tussle.

After being held to one hit in the first four innings by OSC left-hander, Don White, the Beavers tagged him for four hits and three runs in the fifth and drove him from the hill with four more hits and 2 runs in the sixth. Ward Rocky finished the game and prevented any further Beaver scoring the remainder of the way.

The Lumberjacks really fattened their batting averages on Sunday, slamming out a total of 28 base hits. Starting pitcher, Jim Nierman, was the victim of four unearned runs in the first, got by in the second inning, facing only three batters, but was shelled off the mound in the third as Stetter and Arlitt lead off with singles and the former coast leaguer, Dick Wenner, drove a long home run over the left field wall. Bill Wallace and Bill Darnell, in turn tried their hand at pitching but it remained for Jerry Mason to come in from center-field to end the 11-run splurge and also pitch the last five innings. Eight Brookings errors aided considerably in the scoring.

The Beavers got 15 hits off Al Treichel, former National League and Coast League pitcher, but couldn't bunch them effectively, only in the sixth an eighth innings.
