

## Social Security Is Of Importance

EUGENE — Four times each year the Eugene social security office faces the problem of trying to prevent workers and their families in Curry county from losing some of their future social security benefits, said Claude E. Dawson, manager of that office.

Dawson said the problem arises from the quarterly social security tax returns filed each three months by employers. These reports should show the correct name and social security number of each worker. If the number is omitted or reported incorrectly, the worker cannot receive credit for his wages unless the social security administration is able to obtain the correct information.

Dawson explained that employers and employees in Curry county can prevent this by making certain that each name and number is reported exactly as it appears on the employee's social security card.
