Robert Swan, and the hostesses will be glad to pass the recipe on to anyone phoning them for the baked lemon pudding—a tasty, easy to make light dessert.

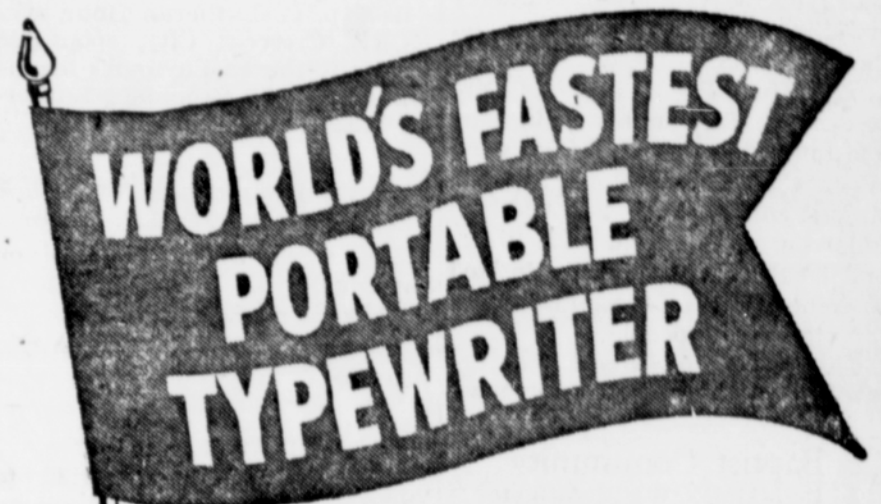
