

Beavers Drop Two Games To Loggers

The Brookings Beavers ended a dismal Southwestern Oregon league schedule by dropping both games at Coquille over the week-end. The Loggers took the Saturday night game 5 to 0 and then slugged their way to a 11 to 5 triumph on Sunday afternoon.

Dick Gilson, UCLA hurler, whom the Beavers had always been able to beat previously, was plenty tough Saturday night, giving up but 5 singles. Only in the second were the Beavers able to combine more than one hit per inning. With one down Jim Lowman and Whitey Matson hit successive singles and Keith Johnson was safe on the only Logger error to load the bases but Gilson struck out Bunky Peterson and forced Jim Nierman to ground out, pitcher to first.

Jim Nierman pitched a better than average game, scattering 7 hits. The same combination of a walk, a sacrifice and a hit accounted for single runs in the 1st and 3rd. Two hits in the 4th plus a couple of fielders choice chances which failed to get a runner resulted in 2 more runs and then the Loggers added a needless and unearned run in the 8th.

The Sunday tilt looked like a definite Brookings win for 6 innings with the Beavers enjoying a 4 to 0 lead. Jim Lowman had allowed the Loggers only 3 hits in the first 6 frames but the roof fell in during the 7th. A combination of scratch hits, solid bingles and 3 Beaver errors all added up to a 10 run splurge for Coquille.

Bill Wallace with 2 singles and Jim Lowman with a single, a double and a home run accounted for 5 of the 9 Brookings hits off Logger lefty, John Bilbrey.
