Local Breakwater and Harbor Lights to Change Oct. 1

Two navigation aids in Crescent City harbor will be changed on October 1, the U.S. Coast Guard announced this week.

The harbor lighted bell buoy No. 2-LL No. 756 on the chart—will be changed to a quick flashing red light of 40 candlepower.

The inner breakwater light—LL No. 757—will be changed to flashing white. Characteristic: flash two seconds, eclipse four seconds. A directional type lens will beam 1100 candlepower on

a bearing 019 degrees T approaching the light. In other sectors the light will have an intensity of 60 candlepower.
