

**Lily Growers View Market**

75 Lily growers of Southern Curry County and Northern California met in the Chetco grange hall Wednesday night. The purpose of the meeting was to review the production and marketing of Croft lily bulbs for 1952.

After considering the Lily crop survey recently released by OSC Extension Service and information presented by growers it was felt that this years crop of lilies should move through the regular marketing channels at or about the prices recommended by the Pacific Lily Growers Association last spring.

Reports indicated that California production was under that of last year which would balance the slight increase in Oregon.

While some buyers are reluctant to buy, it is still early in the marketing season and growers should be able to sell the entire crop at a fair price as soon as the market stabilizes. And that cutting

of prices now would not result in the sale of more lily bulbs but will only reduce the total income for this years lily crop, according to Cliff Jenkins, County Extension Agent.

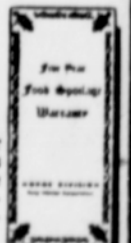
