

Rewards Given For S.S. Attendance

Special honors will be given to members next Sabbath as the Seventh Day Adventist church will pause with fellow churches the world around to observe the 100th anniversary of Adventist Sabbath schools.

Those having the longest continuous Sabbath school membership will top the list of those receiving special mention, also those having the longest continuous record of daily study of the Sabbath school lessons.

There are now 17,373 Sabbath schools with a world membership of 1,034,060.

Since the first Sabbath school was organized, in Rochester, N. Y. in 1852, more than \$81,000,000 have been contributed through this branch of the church to promote the spread of the gospel overseas.

Big Freshman Class Boosts OSC Figures

OREGON STATE COLLEGE—A freshman class that is approximately 250 larger than the one last year combined with the first handful of returning Korean war veterans is boosting registration for fall term at Oregon State college up near the 1951-52 level of 5000.

The increased freshman class is a forerunner of the rapidly expanding registration trend in Oregon that is expected to give OSC some 8000 students by 1960, college officials point out.

Some 25 Korean vets are in school at OSC this term with substantial "reinforcements" expected during winter and spring quarters. Along with them is a sizeable group of veterans from World War II.

Again this year, OSC is drawing large numbers of students from

out-of-state and from foreign countries. Last year there were 36 other state and 33 foreign countries represented.
