A CONTROVERSIAL QUESTION

A question not much discussed but of great interest to our nation is what is called "Tide Land Oil" This probably is a misnomer and the "Tide Land Oil" so called should be designated as "Off Shore Land" or "Marginal Sea Land".

Tide land has always been recognized as that narrow strip of land lying between the ebb of the low tide and the flow of the high tide. It may be only a few yards wide or may be half a mile or more. This land has always been recognized as property of the State and any development therein belongs to the State. However, beyond the tide line there is a continental bench extending out into the ocean. From the low tide line, three miles out into the ocean is the "Marginal Sea", under the supervision of the government whose shore is adjacent to it.

Beneath the lands of the "Off Shore Land" or "Marginal Sea", are immense deposits of natural resources such as oil, minerals, etc.

The controversy is: should the development of these resources be under the State or under the National government? The national government claims the boundary of the State ceases at low tide. The international agreements and the law recognize the "Marginal Sea" or "Off Shore Lands" as under the supervision of the national government.

Should Congress pass a law permitting the States bordering the oceans to enter in a contract with companies or corporations permitting them to develop these natural resources with a certain profit going to the States; or should the development be under the federal government and the profit be distributed among all the states.

The Supreme Court has always held that the national government alone has supervision over the "Marginal Sea" Lands" and Uncle Sam seems to hold that this is a matter for the federal government and that the boundary of the State and its rights cease at the low tide mark.

The Pilot does not presume to answer the question but submits it for clarification of "Tide Land Oil" and "Off Shore Land" or "Marginal Sea Land Oil".
