It was exhibited in the Hall of Religion at the Century of Progress Exposition, Chicago (1933-1934), at the close of which Mr. Baganz purchased it for \$10,000. It is truly a thing of beauty and excellence in construction, tone and volume. The Mirimba in the Ensemble is a concert grand model, the largest and finest obtainable. The Vibraharp, a concert grand, with its scintillating tones reminds one strongly of the German "Glockenspiel." The Cathedral Chimes are a production of the manufacturers of the famous Deagan Bells.

The Repertoire contains among many other musical gems: Abide with Me; Jesus, Joy of Man's Desiring, Haendel's Largo; Vesper Bells, Harre meine Seele, A Mighty Fortress, etc.
