Pledge For Home Defense

Organizations throughout the state are cooperating this month in a "Pledge for Home Defense" campaign in order to build a strong reserve force for civil defense.

The drive began Tuesday, Armistice Day, and will continue through Thanksgiving, Nov. 27.

"Purpose is to get a reservoir of potential volunteers," said Robert Sandstrom of the state civil defense agency. "Members of participating groups—civic, women, veterans, farm—will be asked to indicate their willingness to be counted as potential volunteers to whom the local civil defense organization may offer training and service if the need arises."

The idea behind the campaign,

being supported by more than 100 national organizations, follows Oregon's policy of developing a hard core of trained workers, and having a reserve of people registered and ready to offer their services when needed.
