NOTICE OF HEARINGS UPON
ORGANIZATION OF PRO-
POSED CURRY COUNTY SOIL
CONSERVATION DISTRICT,
EMBRACING LAND LYING IN
CURRY COUNTY, OREGON.

WHEREAS, on the 24th day of
October, 1952, there was duly
filed in the office of the State
Soil Conservation Committee at
Corvallis, Oregon, a petition
signed by 61 landowners, pursu-
ant to the provisions of the Soil
Conservation Districts Law, Chap-
ter 3, Title 109, O.C.L.A., request-
ing the establishment of the Curry
County Soil Conservation District,
and

WHEREAS, the lands described
by said petition, and any other
lands which will be considered
for inclusion in the said district
are located in Curry County and
described substantially as fol-
lows:

All lands located within the
boundaries of Curry County.

NOW, THEREFORE, notice is
hereby given that public hearings
will be held pursuant to the said
petition, on the question of the
desirability and necessity, in the
interest of the general welfare, of
the creation of such district; on
the question of the appropriate
boundaries to be assigned to such
district; upon the propriety of the
petition, and of all other proceed-
ings taken under the said Act;
and upon all questions relevant
to such inquiries. The said pub-
lic hearings will be held by the
State Soil Conservation Commit-
tee on the 4th day of December,
1952, beginning at 10:00 o'clock,
a.m., in the Sixes Grange Hall at
Sixes in the County of Curry; on
the 4th day of December, 1952,
beginning at 8:00 o'clock, p.m., in
the Gold Beach County Court
Room at Gold Beach in the Coun-
ty of Curry; and on the 5th day
of December, 1952, beginning at
1:30 o'clock, p.m., in the Chetco
Grange Hall at Harbor in the
County of Curry.

Every person, firm, corporation,
state, county, or municipal agency
holding title to ten acres or more
land lying within the limits of
the above-described territory, and
all other interested parties are
invited to attend and will be given
opportunity to be heard at the
times and places hereinbefore
specified.

VACATION

The City of Brookings, upon
Motion of its Council, made at the
regular meeting of said council on
the 18th day of November, 1952,
proposes to proceed to vacate the
following described portion of that
certain unnamed alley which ex-
ists between Block B and Block
12 as said alley and said blocks
are shown upon that certain Map,
entitled "Plat No. 1, Brookings,
Curry Co., Oregon," recorded De-
cember 1, 1920, in Book 1, Page 5,
Record of Town Plats in the Of-
fice of the Recorder for Curry
County, Oregon. The portion of
said alley to be vacated is thus
described:

Beginning at the Northwest
corner of Lot 1, Block 12,
Brookings, thence following the
North line of Block 12 to the
Northeast corner of Lot 11 in
said Block 12, thence South 76
deg. 31 min. 40 sec. West diag-
onally across said alley or road-
way, 77.16 feet to a point on
the South line of Block B;
thence following said South line
of Block B, Southwesterly to
the Southwest corner of Block
B, thence South 23 deg. 15 min.
West 20.0 feet, more or less, to
the point of beginning.
This is to notify all persons

affected or otherwise interested
that a public hearing will be held
before said Council in the Council
Chambers, Brookings City Hall,
at the hour of 8 p.m. on the 7th
day of January, 1953, for the pur-
pose of hearing and considering
said Motion and any and all writ-
ten objections and remonstrances
thereto which shall have been
filed with the City Recorder prior
to the convening of said public
hearing.

If from such public hearing
said Council shall determine that
such portion of said alley should
be vacated, it will proceed imme-
diately to effect the vacation
thereof.
