

Hints For Christmas Mail

Address mail carefully, using postal zone numbers for large cities.

Glue address labels to packages and envelopes. Don't tie or wire them as they may be torn off.

Send Christmas cards via first-class mail, using 3-cent stamps; cards sent third class for 2 cents can't be forwarded or returned.

Wrap packages carefully and use the fourth-class printed labels for addresses.

Do not use locker paper as labels and stamps will not stick to it.

Tie packages with strong twine, not by gummed paper alone.

Arrange to mail packages during middle of day. Please don't wait until mail time.

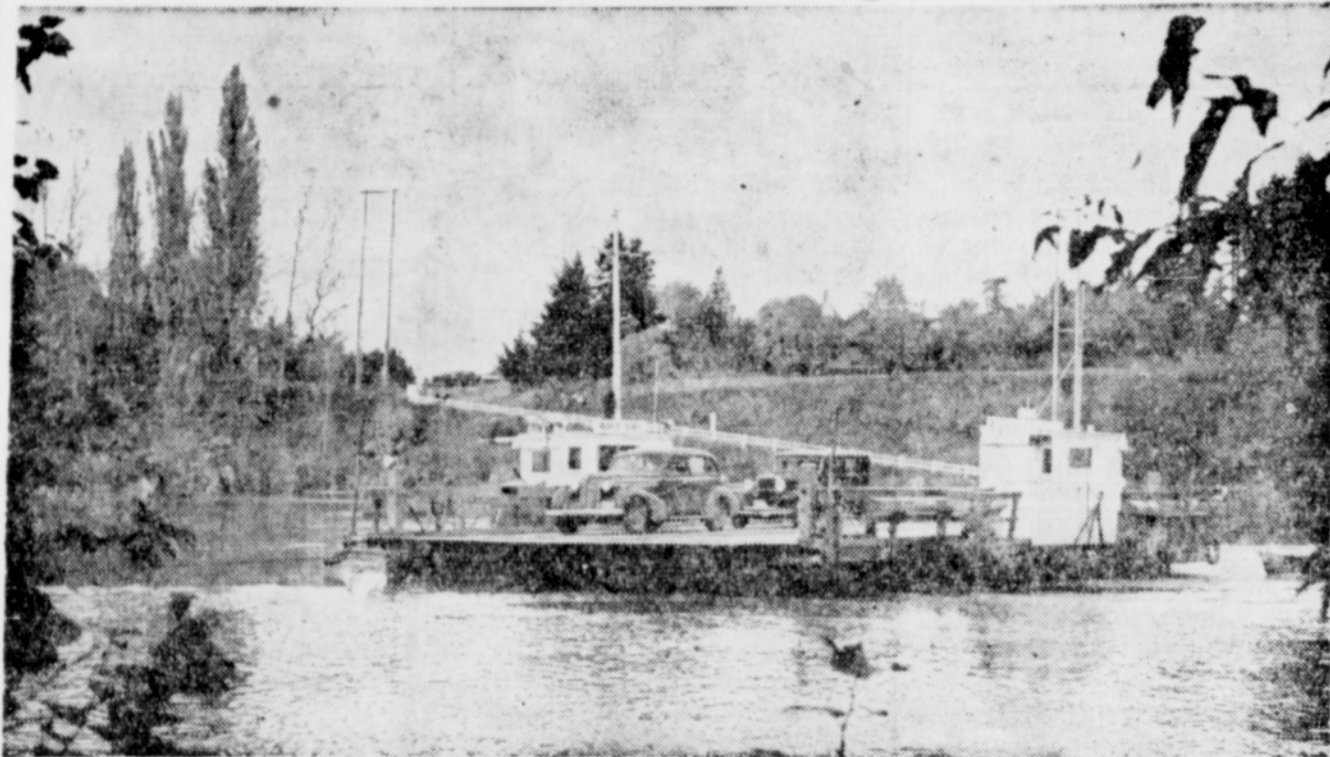

The Last Veteran Fading Away



Alphonso Boone, grandson of the great Daniel, trekked west to Oregon in 1846, settling with his family on the banks of the Willamette across the river from where Wilsonville was to grow. In 1847 the eldest son, Jesse V. Boone, built himself a ferry boat to bridge the water gap for those rugged pioneers wanting to make the then long journey over what became known as the Boone's Ferry Road between Portland and Salem. Jesse was killed in 1871 and his younger brother, Alphonse D. took over the job and for 100 years the old ferry and its successors have carried the public and its vehicles, from ox-drawn to diesel-driven. It will continue faithful to its century-old task until Jan. 1, 1954, when it is expected that the new Boone four-lane bridge will take over the burden. Then this last of the Highway Commission's "fleet", except the Astoria-Megler ferry, can take its rest and become another memory in Oregon's book of pioneers and their history.

Time Nearly Up To Send Parcels Overseas by CARE

Final date for accepting orders for special Christmas turkey packages to be sent overseas by CARE, the non-profit agency which sends food, textile and similar parcels abroad, is Dec 1, Edward J Flynn, western director, announced today

Complete turkey dinners with plum pudding and sweets or all-turkey packages may be sent to many parts of Europe and to some parts of Asia, Mr Flynn said. They go duty and tax free with delivery guaranteed

"CARE has made it possible at the holiday time for Americans to send these special Christmas gift packages to their friends and relatives abroad," Mr Flynn said. "Senders may designate the recipients of the packages. For those who wish to help some needy family abroad, but have no names, CARE will send the parcel in the donor's name. Contributions in any amount are accepted by CARE. CARE packages take no ration stamps from persons in rationed areas."

The turkey dinner package with an eight-pound bird and "trimmings" is priced at \$18.75; an eight-pound turkey packed in lard which is scarce abroad, is \$12.

Orders for any of the packages or contributions in any amount may be sent to the local office of CARE, 215 SE 9th, Portland 14.
