153,000 Oregon Houses Past 30 Years Of Age

Houses grow old a lot faster than people.

As a man passes the age of 30 the insurance people say, he can reasonably expect to reach 71. But a 30-year-old house and there are 153,000 beyond that age in Oregon alone, according to the Gas Appliance Manufacturers association—can be downright decrepit.

If it doesn't suffer from hardening of the plumbing or sclerosis of the heating system, GAMA says, it's more than likely a victim of culinary thrombosis or laundry let-down.

"Assuming an old house remains structurally sound, its dollar value and livability depend on proper facilities for ventilation, for light and heat, for food preparation and preservation, and for personal and household hygiene," the trade group explains.

"This makes home modernization, like preventive medicine for humans, a worthy investment. In fact, with a large group of Oregon's 477,000 non-farm dwellings now past the 30-year mark, modernization becomes a prerequisite to the continued health and well-being of thousands of Beaver state families"

V.F.W. Was First To Sponsor Poppy

Commander Koehler of Post No. 966, Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States, pointed out today in connection with the observance of National V.F.W. Week, Jan. 25-31, that that organization was the first veterans' group to sponsor the annual nationwide sale of memorial poppies.

The first such sale was conducted in 1922 he said, and since then millions of the replicas of Flander's fields' flower have been sold as the "Buddy" poppy, the V.F.W. using the proceeds of these solicitations for rehabilitation and organization's national home, near Eaton Rapids, Mich.

"By now," Commander Koehler said, "the public well knows that every penny contributed to the Veterans of Foreign Wars through its "Buddy" poppy campaigns is devoted to the relief of needy or disabled veterans and their dependents and to help run the national home. There are no deductions whatsoever for administrative expenses

Thus, he explained, the Veterans of Foreign Wars proceeds further in exemplifying its motto: "We honor the dead by helping the living."





