




Oregon Soil Conservation Committee in Corvallis, Oregon.

Plans were being completed by farmer-leaders to contact all landowners within boundaries of the proposed district, and to advise them of its purposes and aims, Watt said. Under state law any landowner with more than ten acres of land in the district area may vote on the referendum.

The district referenda is the final step in the formation of the farmer-action soil conservation district program. Previously favorable hearings had been held and petitions from farmers favoring the district were filed with the state committee.

Two-thirds of the votes cast at the referendum must be favorable to insure passage of the Curry County Soil Conservation District referendum. Any landowner with more than ten acres of land within the boundaries of the proposed district may vote on the issue.

The proposed district includes all of the land in Curry county.

"We're working to get a big turnout of landowners to vote on the referendum," Watt said. "Farmers are showing a lot of interest in the district and are working to put it over. Many farmers are helping because they believe a soil conservation district will help the agriculture of Curry county. They feel that most farmers in the district area need technical and engineering advice. They're looking forward to better times under a district. Landowners will vote for three supervisors to the district governing board."
