NOTICE is hereby given that Sealed Bids will be received at the Office of the City Recorder of the City of Brookings, Oregon, on or before the 14th day of April, 1953, at the hour of 4:30 o'clock p.m. on said date and heard at a public meeting of the City Council of the City of Brookings, State of Oregon, to be held at 8:00 p.m. in the City Hall of the City of Brookings, for providing three wholesome meals per day for each prisoner who may be and while incarcerated in the City Jail at any time during the period from May 1, 1953, to July 1, 1954.

Th bids must be on the single unit (meal) basis and the City of Brookings does not guarantee any minimum number of units (meals) during said period of time nor any minimum number of units (meals) per prisoner.

Each bid must be enclosed in a sealed envelope endorsed "Bid for Prisoners' Meals" and addressed to the City Recorder of the City of Brookings, State of Oregon.
