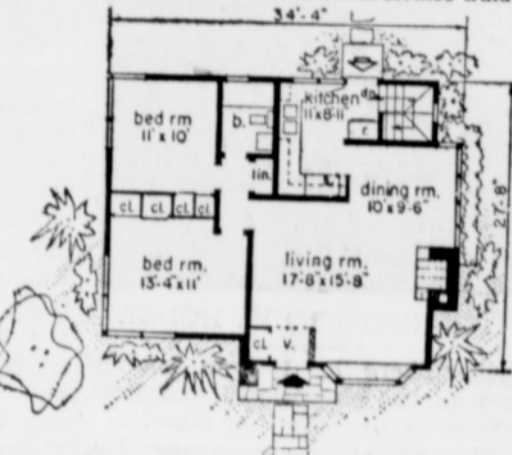
Economy Plan
