Palomino Horse Show at Gresham

GRESHAM, Ore.—Sunday, July 19, has been designated as the date of the third annual All Palomino Horse show here at the Multnomah County fair grounds.

More than 200 entries are expected for the third revival of the show which annually draws the top horses with the unique golden coats and white manes and tails from Northwest stables. Earl Flick, president of the Palomino

Horse Exhibitors of Oregon, said the show is the only one of its kind in Washington and Oregon.

The Palomino show is sponsored by Flick's organization, as an affiliate of Palomino Horse Breeders of America, Inc., and is the proving ground for Palomino breeders throughout the Northwest. The term "palomino" designates color only, according to Flick, and through select breeding and registration, members of the organization hope to establish the golden-coated animals as a recognized breed in the horse world. Each year, Flick said, Palomino breeders bring their animals to the event to show them off to each other and the public.

Entries are being accepted by mail by Mrs. L. H. Cobb, secretary, at 8407 S.W. Birchwood Lane, Portland, Ore.

Glen O. Perkins, past national president of the Palomino Horse Breeders of America, will judge the show.

CENSUS RECORDS ACCEPTED FOR BIRTH CERTIFICATE

Persons lacking birth certificates or other legal evidence of citizenship, age or family relationships can obtain transcripts of their personal census records which are, in most instances, acceptable substitutes, according to District Supervisor Jack W. Traverse, Jr. of the U.S. Census Bureau.

More than 100,000 Americans turned to the census bureau for such evidence in 1952. They needed proof of identity or age for government and defense jobs, social security, passports, the armed services, and in connection with insurance and estate cases.

Supervisor Jack W. Traverse, Jr. pointed out that personal information recorded by the census bureau is entirely confidential and may be furnished only upon the written request of the individual to whom it relates or his legal representatives. The normal fee is \$3 for searches of two censuses for one individual, each application being handled in regular turn which generally requires approximately 30 days to complete service. Expedited handling is furnished for a \$4 fee.

A revised application form for use of persons seeking to establish proof of age or citizenship through personal census records is now available at the census bureau's district office, room 274, Federal building, Sacramento.

The revised form is designed to encourage applicants to use the censuses of 1880, 1900 and 1920, if possible, when requesting searches of the voluminous census records. Officials point out that information from these censuses can be furnished more rapidly because the records for these years have been card indexed. Because of the comprehensive index, information can be provided in most instances if the applicant furnishes only his name, the name of the city or county and state in which he was living and the name of the head of the household in which he was residing. Searches of the card index of these censuses can be conducted five times faster than by the conventional method of looking through the original records.

Persons needing information from the censuses of 1910, 1930, 1940 and 1950 — if residing in a city at the time these censuses were taken — should furnish the house number, name of the street, city, county and state, and the name of the parent or head of the household with whom living. If residing in a small town, they should give all available information as to cross-streets, road names, name of township in which residence was located and any other available pertinent data. Rural residents are asked to furnish the rural route number and also the distance and direction of the residence from the nearest town.
