

Beavers Win Two Exhibition Games

Brookings' Beavers drew a "bye" in Southwestern Oregon league play the past week-end but won two exhibition games, trouncing the Crescent City Merchants 19 to 3 on Saturday and then dumping the Glendale Loggers 8 to 2 on Sunday.

The Beavers slammed out a total of 18 base hits off four Merchant pitchers coming up with 7 runs in the 3rd and an 8-run splurge in the 5th. Erratic fielding on the part of his mates ruined any chance that starting Merchant hurler Don Clausen might have had to win. Jim Barrett went the route for Brookings allowing 6 hits, Bob Selsor, new Beaver shortstop, and Boyd Western each with 3 hits, and Jack Selby, Jay Dean and Ron Monello with 2 blows apiece, led the Brookings hitting attack.

Corky Coleman gave the Glendale Loggers only 4 scattered hits in the Sunday game and deserved a shutout. The Loggers managed their two runs in the top of the 9th without the aid of a hit, four Beaver miscues in that frame doing all the damage. Ken Kimura and Ron Monello hit home runs for Brookings.
