St. Timothy's Episcopal Church Tuesday purchased a new site for their proposed Church and Parish from Warren Smith.

The church site is at the corner of Azalea Park Road and Fir Streets, and includes lots 18 and 19 of the Barrett tract.

Present plans of the Parish are to move their existing church, the smallest active Episcopal Church in the United States, to the new site immediately. The group then plans to begin construction on a new Parish hall as rapidly as possible.

Members of the church were enthusiastic about their new site, which faces Azalea State Park. They expressed their gratitude to Mr. Smith, who's generosity made their new home-site possible.

Negotiations for the church-site were carried on by John C. S. Merrifield of Portland, representing Bishop Dagwell of the Diocese of Oregon, and a committee of local parishioners including Don Finch, senior warden of St. Timothy's; Glen Hurst, junior warden; Roy Brown, treasurer; Bill Dubs, vestryman, the Reverend Ernest Bartlam, the Reverend Mr. Greenfield of Bandon, Mrs. Bill Dubs president of St. Timothy's guild, Mrs. Bill Brown, Mrs. Don Finch, Mrs. Jean Sanders, Mrs. Glenn Zirbel and Mrs. Edith Hines.

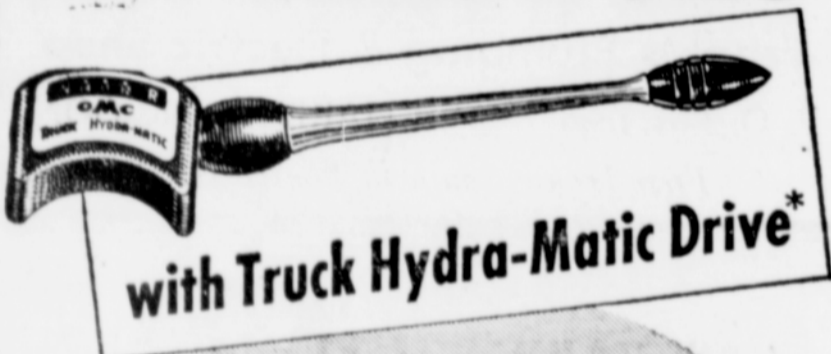
