## Radio-Telephone Service Furnished For Night Train

Passengers on Southern Pacific's "Cascade", streamlined night train between Portland and San Francisco are now able to talk by radio-telephone with any part of the world, through facilities of Pacific Telephone. The service began July 14, the railroad has announced.

"This installation, first of its kind in Pacific Northwest train service, has been completed by Southern Pacific to bring the convenience of two-way commercial telephone service on a moving train to travelers on the 'Cascade'," said J. H. Pruett, Jr., the railroad's general passenger agent in Portland.

Cost of using the new "Voice of the Cascade" will be about the same as cost of daytime person-to-person calls on office or home telephones, according to the Pacific Telephone Company, into whose communication network the radio-telephone service will be tied.

Radio-telephone booths have been installed in the dining cars of the twin trains. The phones will be coin operated, Pruett said but other than that, the use of the service will be as simple as telephoning at home.

The train calls will be handled through the telephone company's radio stations in Portland, Eugene, Salem, Oakland and Sacramento.

Radio-telephone service is also available on Southern Pacific's "Lark", night train between San Francisco and Los Angeles, Pruett pointed out.

## Loans to Veterans For Homes Eased

Eligible veterans will be able to borrow up to \$9,000 for the acquisition of homes, or \$15,000 to acquire farms, under the Oregon veterans' 4 per cent loan program that commenced Tuesday, July 21, the effective date of the more liberal lending program approved by the 1953 legislature.

The maximum available under existing law has been \$6,000 for both homes and farms.

Ernest J. Smith, loan supervisor for the state Department of Veterans' Affairs, the administering agency, pointed out that loans continue to be limited to 75 per cent of the appraised value of the property, so that a home appraising at \$10,000, for example, would warrant a loan of not more than \$7,500.

To be eligible, an applicant must have been a veteran of either World War II or the current emergency. He must either have been an Oregon resident when he entered active duty, or have come to Oregon and lived here for two years following his discharge. In the case of World War II veterans, the two-year post-war residence must have been prior to December 31, 1950. Service in either period must have been for 90 days or more and have been honorable.

There is no deadline for applying. Applications by mail should be submitted to the Department of Veterans' Affairs, State Library Building, Salem. Veterans applying in person may go either to the Salem headquarters or to the Portland office of the department in the State Office Building.
