lice action, and never make the list of declared wars. On the surface it never accomplished very much, except the destruction of Korea, because it ended just about where it began, along the 38th parallel.

But this police action will not go unmarked in history. Here American forces suffered probably their most destructive defeat in history, on the long retreat from the Yalu. . . and with it they covered themselves with glory. In their heroic defense of Pusan, they wrote a new chapter of heroism for our pages.

And here, too, something new in International cooperation first appeared. For the first time in history, the free nations of the world lined up solidly together to tell an aggressor that he could not seize a nation. . . and, at the end, they were still together.

Vague and imperfect as this truce is, and cruel as the Korean war has been, it has given birth to a new tenant that may reshape the course of world events for years to come. For the first time, free men have joined to protect the weak from the strong.
