## National Forest Timber For Sale

Sealed bids will be received by the Forest Supervisor, Post Office Building, Grants Pass, Oregon up to and not later than 2:00 P.M., PST, September 10, 1953, for all the live timber marked or designated for cutting and all merchantable dead timber located on an area embracing about 10 acres within Section 19, T. 40S., R. 12W., W.M., Mill Creek drainage, Siskiyou National Forest, Oregon, estimated to be 240,000 bd. ft., more or less, of Douglas-fir and 10,000 bd. ft., more or less, of western hemlock and other species of sawtimber. No bid of less than \$17.65 per M bd. ft. for Douglas-fir and \$1.40 per M bd. ft. for western hemlock and other species will be considered. In addition to the prices bid for stumpage, a cooperative deposit of \$0.45 per M bd. ft. to be used by the Forest Service for paying the cost of slash disposal and a cooperative deposit of \$1.00 per M bd. ft. to cover the cost of tree planting, seed sowing and other timber stand improvement work on the area cut over for the total cut of timber under the terms of the agreement will be required. \$2000.00 must accompany each bid to be applied on the purchase price, refunded, or retained in part as liquidated damages, according to the conditions of sale. The right to reject any and all bids is reserved. Forest Service bid forms for use in submitting sealed bids and full information concerning the timber, the conditions of sale, and the submission of bids should be obtained from the Forest Supervisor, Grants Pass, Oregon, or the District Ranger, Brookings, Oregon before bids are submitted. On August 24, 1953 at 9:00 A.M., a forest officer will be available to explain the conditions of the sale and to conduct a tour to show the timber offered for sale. The party will assemble at the office of the District Ranger on Easy Street in Brookings, Oregon.


