New Veterinarian In Smith River

There's a new veterinarian in Smith River, and the Brookings Chamber of Commerce brought him there.

The new veterinarian is Dr. W. H. Townsend, who this week opened an office in Smith River. Dr. Townsend will conduct a small-animal clinic as well as his practice in large-animal diseases.

Dr. Townsend came to Smith River in response to information sent to the State College of Washington by the Brookings Chamber. The Chamber had requested help in getting a veterinarian in this area, and the college referred the material to Dr. Townsend, a graduate of the college.

Dr. Townsend was just recently discharged from the army, where he was a Captain in the Veterinary Corps at Fort MacArthur. Most of his work in the army was concerned with inspection of milk and meat for army consumption. Earlier he had practiced for several years in Stanwood, Wash.

Dr. Townsend plans to start construction immediately upon a small-animal hospital in Smith River to house his small-animal practice, and will operate it in conjunction with his large-animal laboratory.

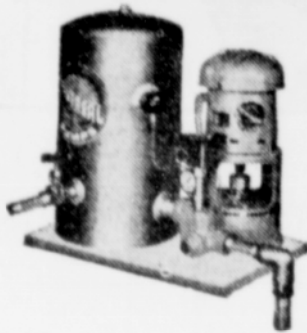

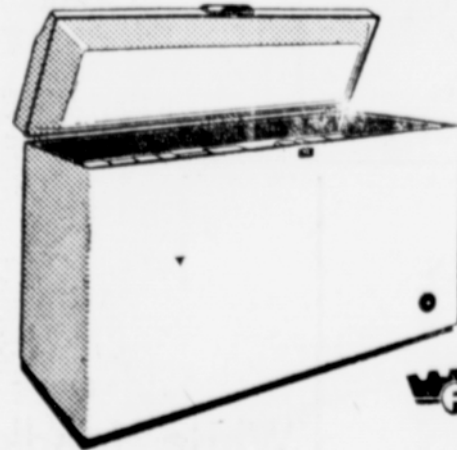
