NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT at the School District Bond Election hereby called to be held at the Brookings-Harbor School house in and for School District No. 17C, Curry County, Oregon, on Tuesday the 15th day of September, 1953, between the hours of two o'clock P.M. and eight o'clock P.M. there will be submitted to the legal voters thereof the question of contracting a bonded indebtedness in the sum of Three hundred seventy-eight thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$378,500.00) for the purpose of providing funds with which to acquire, to construct, to equip and to furnish a high school building, including class rooms, gymnasium, cafeteria and shop and for the improvement of school grounds adjacent thereto, all in and for said District.
