When the typing program is complete it will be possible to arrange for transfusions locally just by checking the previously determined blood types of the victim and the prospective donors.

Oregon Colleges List Openings

EUGENE—Enrollment in Oregon's state higher educational institutions is expected to be about 13,000 again this fall, the state board of higher education office reported Saturday.

The beginnings of double enrollments within the decade showed up last year when a one per cent increase was noted over the 1951-52 school year. Korean war veterans totaled 568 last year, but a federal veteran's administration spokesman estimated in Washington this week that

Korean war vet enrollment would double this fall nationally.

In the state system of higher education, the three colleges of education at Monmouth, Ashland and La Grande will begin freshman days on September 17 and classes are scheduled to start September 22.

The University of Oregon and Oregon State college begin "New Student Week" on September 13 and classes on September 21. Portland State Extension Center day program opens with counseling and advising on September 14, classes on September 21. The Portland State night program opens September 14.
