Numerous complaints have been made that target shooters are using Mill and Harris beaches for their target practice. In addition to being illegal, the procedure is highly dangerous, since both beaches are used extensively. In addition, shooters have been seen aiming at the gulls which frequent the beaches. This, also, is contrary to law, both municipal and state.

Residents of houses fronting the sea have been perturbed in recent weeks by the lack of care shown by the shooters illegally using the city beaches.
