was afraid to go home. In addition, two women with whom Wanda stayed after the first trial testified that Shields' visits upset Wanda, and one of them, Mrs. Maude Huestis of Eugene, asked the welfare department to ban Shields from visiting Wanda.

District Attorney Hall's case was built around the acts of Nodine prior to the murder, in which he attempted to prove premeditation. A series of witnesses related hearing threats directed against Shields by Nodine.

Clifford Shields, chief witness for the prosecution, related his version of the shooting on Sixes road. He told that Nodine had passed his car, both cars had stopped, and that Nodine backed up and got out of his car. He said that Nodine brought out a
