**Library Board Has  
Monthly Meeting**

Six trustees, the librarian and one assistant librarian were present at the monthly board meeting of the Chetco Community Public Library last Monday evening.

Dues for two new members and one renewal membership to the Library Association was turned over to the treasurer. Also a donation of nine dollars was turned over to the library general fund.

It should be made clear that one does not have to be a member of the Association in order to borrow books from the library. It is a public library and its services are free to all. The Association membership dues are the only means available for funds to operate the library and buy new books. By joining the association you signify your faith in the good which a free public library can do for your community. The annual dues are \$2.50, and it is hoped that a large percentage of the adult population will join. We not only need the dues for maintenance and books but we need man power. At the annual meeting next July there will be four officers and two trustees elected and these will be chosen from the membership list. Most of the current officers have served for several years and they are hoping to be relieved of their duties next year.

The building committee reported they are now ready to pour the concrete floor for the main library building. Mr. Ross Salvage donated and delivered five loads of gravel and Mr. Bankus of the Brookings Red-i-Mix has offered to donate the necessary concrete. Mr. Allsup and Mr. English have offered their services as cement finishers so this part of the building should be done this week.

The librarian reported a substantial increase in the number of books borrowed last month. She reported the donation of a very interesting book "Know Your Rocks" by the Mount Emily Gem and Mineral Society, and several books donated by private parties. She has also sent in an order for 22 new books which will be on our shelves within a short time. Some of the new books for juvenile readers will be paid for by a donation which was made by the Girl Scouts for this purpose.

The library is open Tuesday and Friday afternoons from two to five o'clock. Beginning this Friday it will also be open from 11 to 1 o'clock every Friday noon throughout the winter for the convenience of school children.

The Oregon State Highway Commission last week rejected a petition filed by the Curry County Court protesting the proposed location of US Highway 101 between Gold Beach and Ophir.

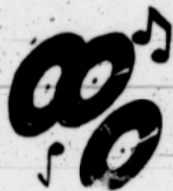
The action took place at the Commission's regular Portland meeting.
