No New Census

Brookings won't get the special census which it recently requested from the secretary of state's office.
Under a ruling handed down by the state attorney general, the secretary of state's office says they are prohibited from making any special census for cities which have had them since 1950. Brookings had one at the time of incorporation, in 1951.
The census had been requested by the city to reevaluate the base on which they receive funds from the state agencies.

No Location Yet

No one has yet offered to provide quarters for a new post office in Brookings, according to Postal Inspector Melvin Northrip of Seattle.
The Post Office Department has advertised locally for a new location for the post office, which has outgrown its present quarters. A minimum of at least 1800 feet are required in the new location. Particulars on the requirements for the building can be obtained at the post-office locally. The request for bids closes October 30.
