A contributing factor to the council's decision, the mayor added, was the fact that insurance on the city equipment was not valid except on authorized runs, and there would be no protection for it on calls outside the city.

The action of the council was taken only shortly before an

alarm from Harbor. City firemen answered the call, which proved to be minor, but left the equipment home.

The decision leaves rural dwellers around Brookings faced with no protection from fire. Formation of a fire-prevention district there, however, would enable them either to acquire their own equipment or contract with Brookings for protection.
