

Oregon Greenery OK In California

The time of year is approaching when many individuals want to take or send cut Christmas greenery to their friends and relatives in California. If you are one of these persons, just go ahead as though you were taking them to your neighbor across the street.

You don't need any inspection on cut greenery (holly, salal, fern, huckleberry and similar cut items) to take them into California. And you won't have any trouble getting them across the border stations at the California line. This is the word from the Oregon department of agriculture based on contact with plant officials of the California department.

Persons should bear in mind this applies only to cut greenery. Plants as such come under provisions of the state nursery law here, which entails licensing and inspection for dangerous pests and diseases.

Local Women Attend School
